



## LIST OF RECOMMENDED TOOLS

If you have taken a Handyman/woman course at the Eli Mo School, here is a list of recommended tools you may want to own. You can purchase most of these tools at Max Stock or any good hardware store

- 1) A power drill. Needs to have hammer drill mode
  - a. Easier and better to buy a battery powered drill, but they are more expensive and less powerful than plug in drills
- 2) A set of various drill bits (for concrete and wood), plugs (dibbles) and assorted screws. You can buy a set that includes all of these together, or you can buy them individually.
- 3) Putty knife. Small bucket of pre-mixed plaster
- 4) Hammer
- 5) Pliers (or a couple sizes of pliers)
- 6) Adjustable wrench
- 7) Screwdrivers > Philips X head, Flat head, Small electrical flat head
- 8) Wire strippers
- 9) Tape measure
- 10) Level
- 11) Assorted tapes and glues / Hi Tack, Epoxy recommended
- 12) Drain snake (plastic with barbs)

There are several other tools, fasteners that you also may want to have in your kit. Generally these tools will last a lifetime.
